



**The Nineteenth Annual
CMSC
Metro Cup Golf Outing
(Corona Cup!)**



On Saturday, August 29, 2020 The Cleveland Metro Ski Council will host the *Nineteenth Annual CMSC Metro Cup Golf Outing* at Punderson State Park Golf Course and Lodge in Newbury, Ohio, featuring golf, lunch, chicken and rib dinner, refreshments, prizes, and great fun!

In this golf outing CMSC Ski Clubs compete in five events for the "Metro Cup", a rotating trophy emblazoned with winning team names. The competitive events include: Men's Medal, Women's Medal, Best Ball, Coed Scramble and Four Person Scramble. The Best Ball and Four Person Scramble teams may be all male, all female, or any combination thereof. Points are awarded in each division, first through last place. The club that accumulates the most points wins the Metro Cup! There is also a rotating trophy for the winning Four Person Scramble Team. First place winners in each division will get a "gold" medal commemorating their win. **Golfers over 70 may elect to hit from the Green Tees.**

To enter a **complete** team your club needs 10 golfers, with an entry in each of the five divisions. Due to Covid-19 each club may only have one full team or partial team and one four person scramble team (14 person maximum). Prizes are awarded for individual events, skill shots and some not so skillful shots!

Golf Package Includes: \$91 per person includes 18 holes of golf, cart, chicken and rib dinner (vegetarian available upon request), lunch, on course refreshments, prizes, and fun. Post golf refreshments and dinner take place at the scenic lakeside Punderson State Park Lodge. If you want dinner only, the cost will be \$30. Golf only \$62.00. **IF YOU PREFER TO BE ALONE ON A CART, THERE IS A \$10.00 CHARGE IF THEY ARE AVAILABLE.**

Registration Due to Covid-19 we will be doing tee times starting at **NOON**. Please do not show up more than ½ hour before your tee time which will be given to all of the team captains no later than Wednesday, August 26, 2020.

| 1) Men's Medal Play | Play their own ball throughout the round and record their own individual scores. |
| 2) Women's Medal Play | Play their own ball throughout the round and record their own individual scores. |
| 3) Two Person Best Ball | Each one plays his/her own ball during the round and records his/her individual score for each hole. |
| 4) Four Person Scramble | Play typical Scramble format. |
| 5) Two Person COED Scramble | Same as Four Person Scramble with one male and one female golfer. |

Detailed rules distributed at outing

The Best Ball and Four Person Scramble teams can be all men, all women, or any combination.
Two person COED Scramble is one man and one woman.

The Golf Package is \$91.00 per person and includes 18 holes, cart, lunch, rib and chicken dinner, refreshments, and prizes.
Golf only (no dinner) is \$62.00. For dinner only, the cost is \$30.00.

Metro Cup points are awarded in each division from first place through last place. The ski club team that accumulates the most total points wins the Metro Cup Trophy for the year. Prizes will be awarded to at least the first place winners in each division. Ski Clubs may enter more than one team in each division.
