

#### DAY 1 • Depart U.S.

Fly from the U.S. to Zagreb, Croatia.

#### DAY 2 • Zagreb, Croatia

Arrive in Zagreb, and meet your fellow travelers, including those who took the *Alpine Wonders of Slovenia: Lake Bled & Ljubliana* pre-trip extension.

#### DAY 3 • Zagreb

Enjoy a guided tour of Croatia's capital with a stroll through the Lower Town. Then, take the funicular to the Upper Town to visit several of the city's medieval landmarks, ending in Zagreb's most colorful market.
